


Welcome back! We hope you had a wonderful Easter break and you are ready and refreshed for a superb summer term.

Maths


In our maths learning this term, we will be continuing to develop our understanding of decimals and fractions. We will be focusing on dividing decimals by 10 and 100, comparing decimals, ordering decimals and rounding decimals.

Topic – The world outside my window

In geography we will locate main counties and cities around school locality, with a study a seaside region of the UK. History will take us on an adventure of a local study.
